whispered.

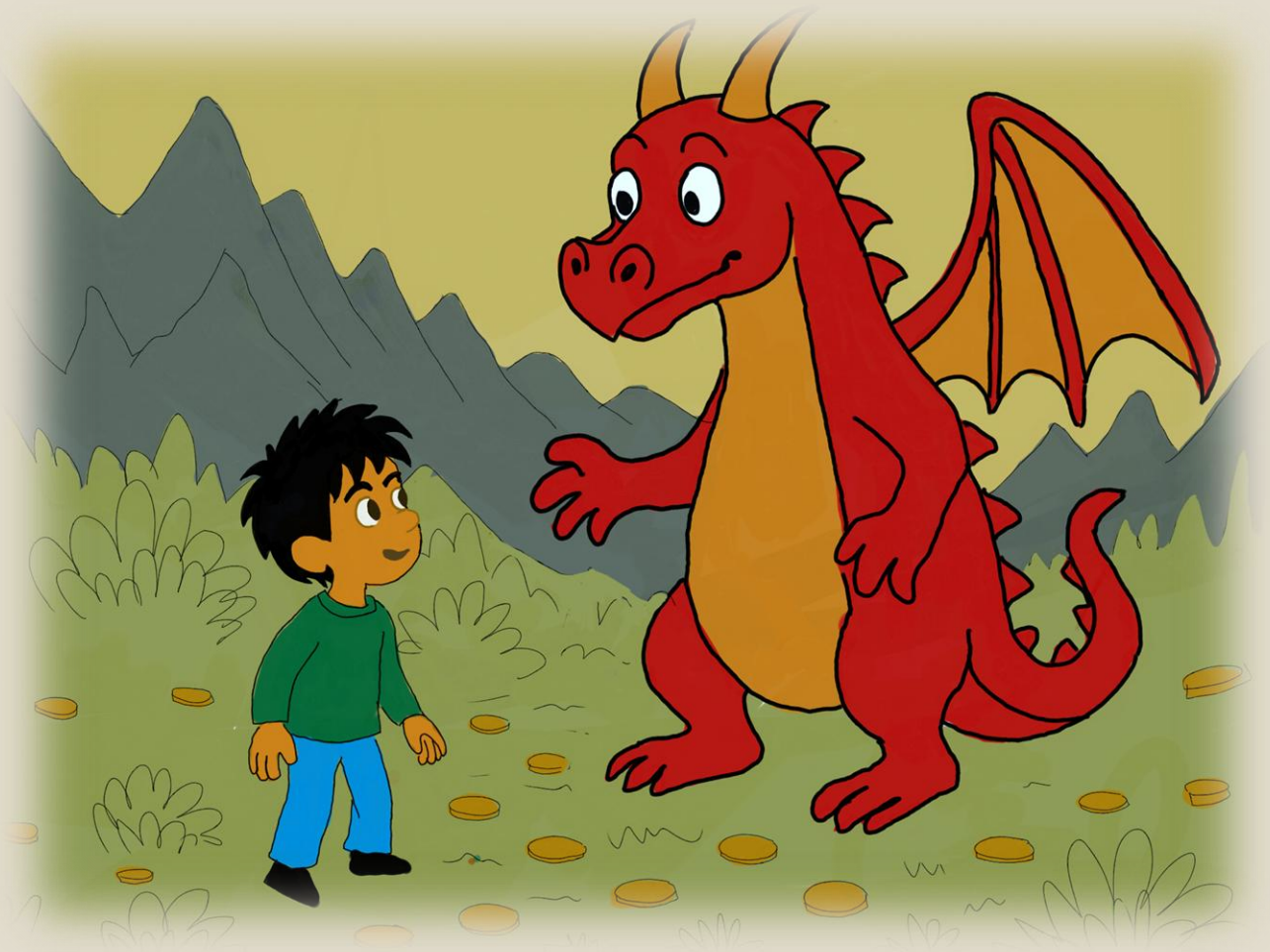


A red dragon with glasses flew down.

“I save a little each time I get money. It adds up!”

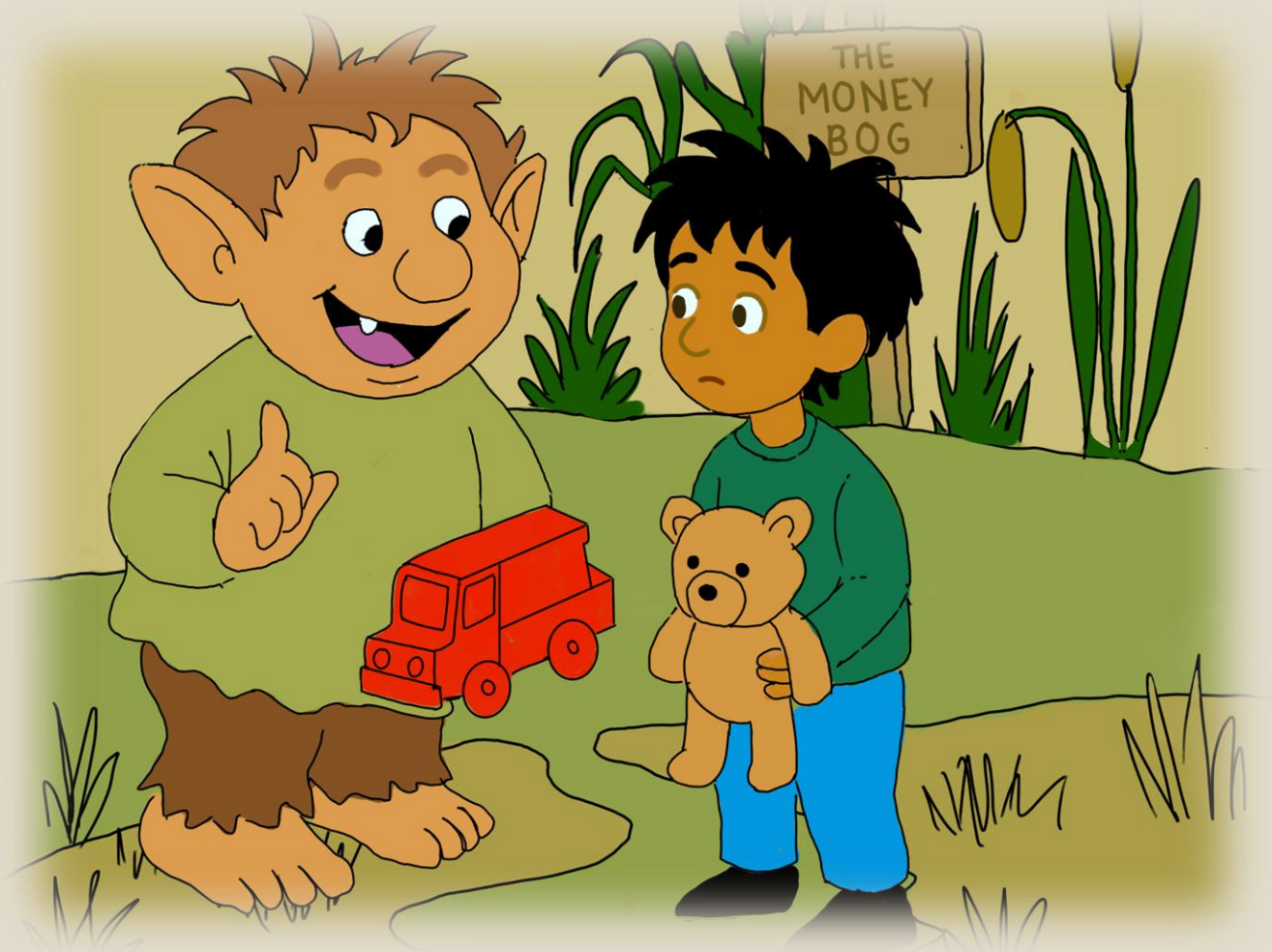
Sid grinned. “Like saving for moon boots!”

The sky flamed bright as a phoenix landed nearby, glowing warmly.

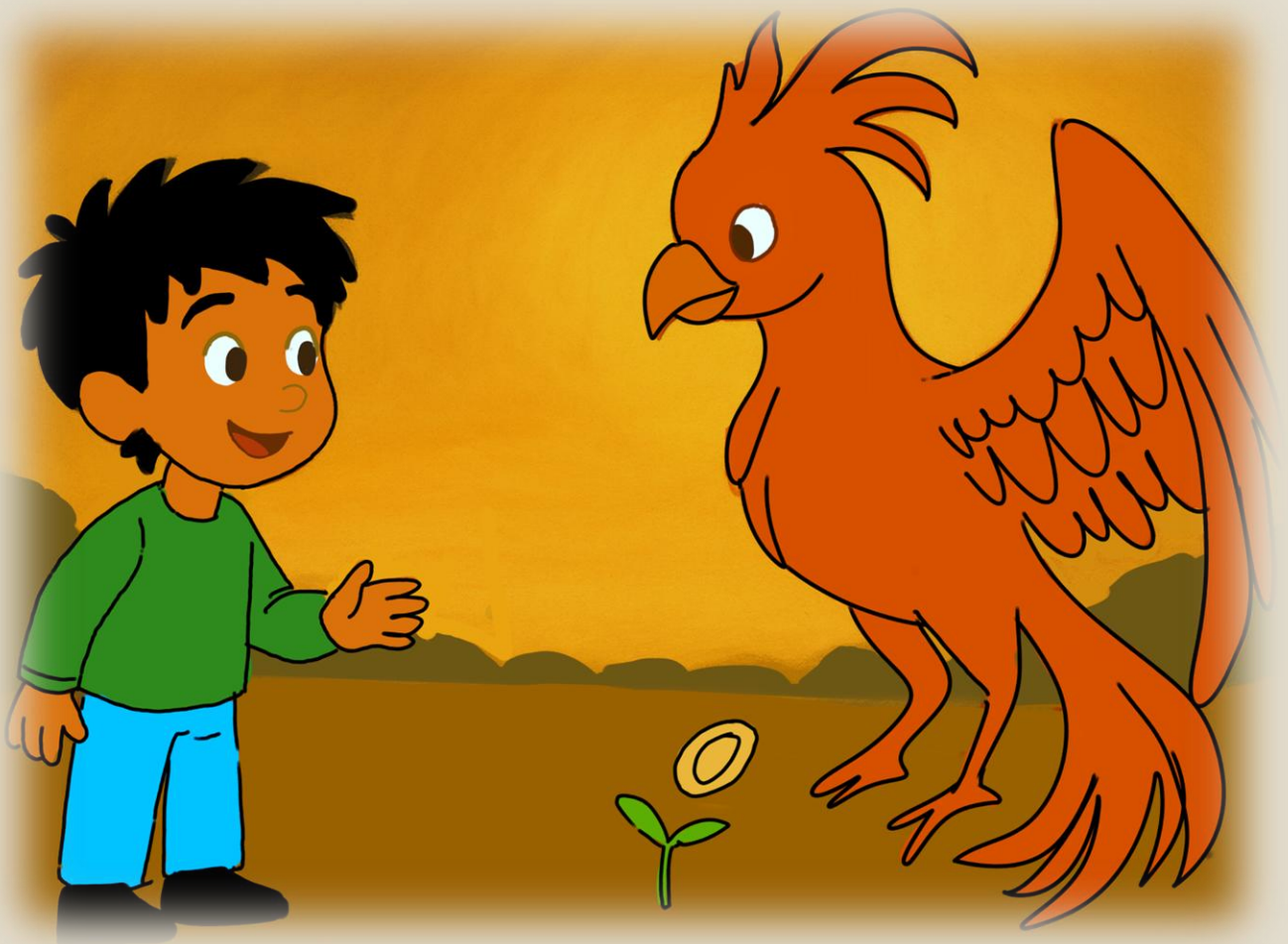
“I’m Investina,” she said gently.
